GRAFFITI

Maybe some feel it is an art form but Thrapston Town Council has a zero tolerance policy towards ALL graffiti and promises to do their best to ensure the removal of any that appears in the town whether on private or public buildings. The following is an extract from the Town Council's policy:

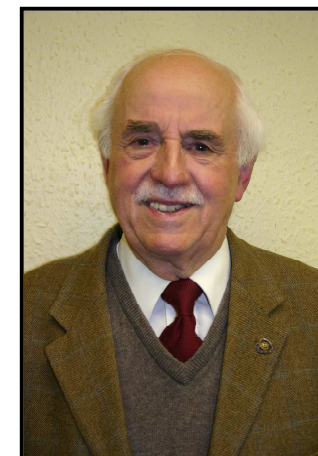
The Council recognises that any graffiti has a negative impact on the environment and will remove it from its property within three working days of any sightings or report and if offensive will remove within 24 hours. The Council will request the owner of a private building on which graffiti appears to remove it and will provide advice on different methods of removal, environmentally sustainable products suitable and if appropriate will offer assistance. Should the graffiti not be removed within 28 days, the Council may serve a graffiti removal notice (Section 48 Anti-Social Behaviour Act 2003) This Act allows for a 'Graffiti Removal Notice' to be issued to the owner of a property outside the ownership of the Town Council. Failure to comply with such a notice may result in the Council carrying out and charging for the works in default (subject to the right of appeal).

We appeal to residents and businesses in Thrapston to be vigilant and help us to keep our town 'graffiti free'. Should you see any graffiti in the town please report it immediately to the Town Clerk on 01832 734673 or call in to the office on the corner of the High Street and Oundle Road. A full copy of the Graffiti Policy and further information can be obtained from the Town Clerk on the above details.
